ABOUT SOLARAID

We are an international charity providing access to solar lights in Malawi and Zambia to help catalyse solar markets with renewable light.

Nearly 600 million people are having their days cut short living without electricity in sub-Saharan Africa. A small invention like a solar light can change that.

Our mission is to light up every home, school and clinic in Africa by 2030, using safe, clean, solar power.



OUR IMPACT 2.1 million lights distributed worldwide.

11 million people in sub-Saharan Africa reached by clean, safe, affordable light.

2.2 million tonnes of CO_2 emissions averted from the atmosphere.

SOLAR STORIES

DEREK DREAMS OF BECOMING A TEACHER

Derrick studies at Nyakantingi primary school in Zambia. When the sun sets, there is nothing left to do but to go to sleep, as the village, lacking electricity, becomes pitch black.

In 2019, a Light Library was introduced at Derrick's school. It allows students to borrow a light, so that they can study after the sun has set. Derrick is one of the students that has been borrowing a solar light to take home in the evenings.

Since borrowing light, Derrick's studies have transformed. His teacher Ms. Michelo says, "He has turned out to be the best reader in the school. He wasn't like that before. He has the motivation within himself. He wants to see himself out of that poverty."

ST LUKE'S HOSPITAL

St. Luke's Hospital in rural Zambia was one of the many healthcare facilities operating without light. Each night, expectant mothers would have to come to the hospital with their own light so that they didn't have to give birth in the pitch black.

Now, St. Luke's hospital uses solar light, and healthcare has changed. Sister Martha says, "Before there was darkness. There is light now. The sun shines for us, for the people, for everybody."

£272 pays for the distribution of 68 solar lights, helping the environment by averting 72.2 tonnes of CO2 emissions.

£412 pays for the distribution of 103 solar lights, allowing 270 people to live healthier lives.

£96 pays for the distribution of 24 solar lights, creating 24,100 extra hours of study time for children at night.

ELLA


Ella Collins ran the entire length of the Thames Path – covering a distance of almost 300km!

The Direct Debit Guarantee

The Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.

If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit, SolarAid will notify you within 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request. If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by SolarAid or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society. If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when SolarAid asks you to.

You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
